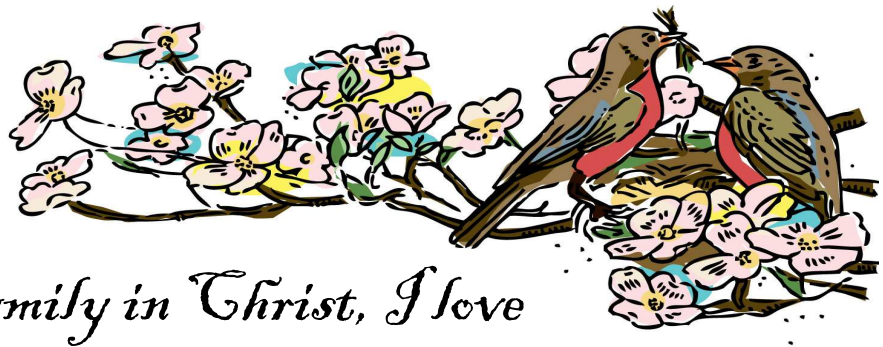

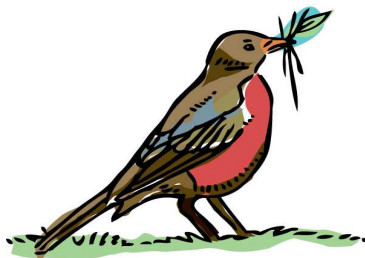

Fowler Facts

This is the third in a series of information about Juliette Fowler Homes. For the next four months Fowler Facts will focus on the four program areas at JFH.

The Children, Youth & Family Service program has three distinctive components. It is a Residential Treatment Program (RTP) for teenage girls ages 12-years to 18-years. This 24-hour resident treatment program helps young women who are emotionally, behaviorally or mentally disturbed. Many of these young residents have suffered from abuse and need help with anger management, low self esteem, as well as many other issues that prevent them from a happy and healthy life.

The Transitional Living Program (TLP) is a continuance of the RTP. This program is one that helps these young girls transition into an independent life. They learn how to apply for a job, fill out applications, often study for their GED and learn the many different skills needed to live on their own.

The Dallas Independent School District provides JFH with two special education school teachers who often work very hard with the young residents in bringing them up to grade level, as well as graduate or successfully take their GED.

Out Patient Counseling is also available for individuals (female or male) of all ages and families. All three services are available to anyone who meets the criteria. If you know a young girl who may need these services or an individual or family group please have them call the Children, Youth & Family Services program at JFH – 214-827-0813.
