## From Your Minister . . .

Her name was Samantha and she was in her mid thirties when she came to me asking whether she might be baptized. I was surprised to hear her say that she had never been baptized since she had been a part of the church for as long as I had been the minister there. No, she told me, she hadn't been baptized before, but she felt that the time was now right for her to take this important step. How happy the members of her family and church were about her decision and how we all rejoiced on the day she was baptized. A few months ago I heard that Samantha had unexpectedly passed away, and I remembered the joy that surrounded her baptism and gave thanks for the comfort that this same memory must be bringing to her family during that time of loss.

On Palm Sunday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, at our traditional worship service I will be baptizing members of our congregation who have chosen to take this important step in their journey of faith. If you have never been baptized and you feel that God is calling you to do so, I hope that you will call me to discuss your participation in our baptism service. Some of the most meaningful baptisms in which I have participated involved adults who had come to worship for many years and participated in the life of the church but simply hadn't gotten around to taking this important step.

I recommend that young people wait until they are at least 11 years old before making this decision. However, if there are children who feel that they are ready to be baptized, if their parent or parents agree, and if they can demonstrate that they understand the fundamentals of Christian faith, then I believe their desire to be baptized should be honored. If this description fits your child and you would like to discuss their participation in our baptism service on April 9<sup>th</sup> please call me this week so that we can discuss it further.

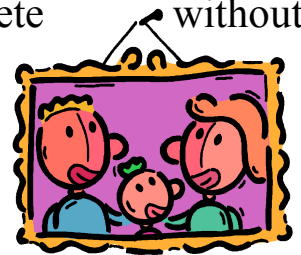
## Wednesday Bible Study

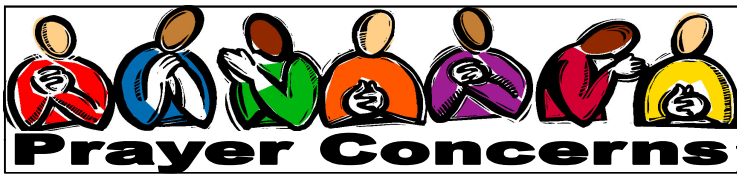
### CPR Classes

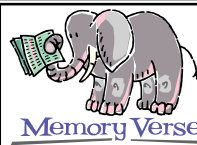
