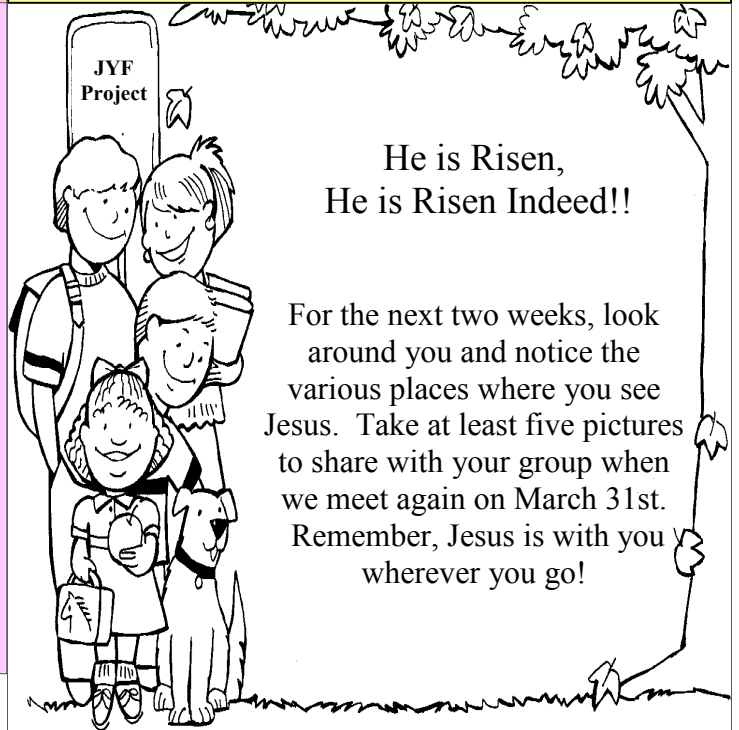


**A Special "Thank You"

Highlights of March 10, 2008 Board Meeting

- Addition of Faye Farmer to staff in Pastoral Care.
- Statements for giving for the first two months will be going out to members within the next two weeks.
- Brown Bag Bible Study on Fridays led by Betty Webster is going very well. All are invited to attend.
- A new 20+ class begins in April and will be taught by David Brice.
- First-time visitors receive a personal call from a member of the Evangelism team. Five members have joined the church thus far in 2008.
- Membership and Evangelism teams will co-host a music concert on July 16. Rev. Greg Bunton from Edmond, Oklahoma will be delivering the concert.
- Twenty-four persons donated blood recently. The next opportunity will be June 29.
- Trustees approved the sale of the blue van. New acoustic panels are to be installed soon in the Family Life Center.

SYMPTOMS OF A HEART ATTACK IN WOMEN

It is my strong wish that all of the women of our church would pass this article on via e-mail, word-of-mouth, etc. to all of their female friends, co-workers, family members, etc. It is of paramount importance that ALL women be educated about the signs and symptoms of a heart attack. It is known by the official term, myocardial infarction (or MI). The American Heart Association is making a valiant effort to educate the public about the subtle differences between the presentation of an MI in men versus women. Don't think you are exempt just because you are a young woman, either, because it can occur even in the young adult years.

Let's compare the two. The classic pain of cardiovascular disease in men is pain below the sternum (breastbone) characterized by a heavy, crushing, or squeezing feeling. This pain in men commonly occurs during physical exertion or with strong emotion, such as fear, anger, grief, etc.- or it may occur at rest. In women, however, the pain is often described as heaviness, squeezing, or pain in her left chest, abdomen, mid-back, or shoulder. *If she doesn't have chest pain, she may have arm pain.* She may feel heart palpitations (flips) or pain described as sharp or fleeting, but *it may return.* During an actual heart attack (MI), discomfort is more likely to occur in her neck, back, arm, shoulder, jaw, or throat, *possibly* accompanied by symptoms such as nausea and vomiting, *indigestion*, upper abdominal pain, shortness of breath, fatigue, sweating, dizziness, or fainting. *An older woman, or one with diabetes, may not experience any pain during an MI.*
