From your Senior Minister.....

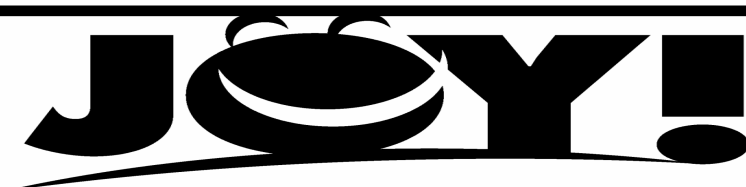
