## A Review of Classic Angina

Angina is the pain from a heart undergoing decrease in oxygen, usually due to a decrease in blood flow. This is in most cases, because of a blockage in one of the coronary arteries. Often angina is perceived as tightness in the chest, or a heaviness (like a weight on top of the chest). In women there can be slightly different symptoms such as right chest and arm discomfort and jaw pain. It is unknown why men and women have different presentations of the same disease processes.

If you believe you might have angina it is imperative to see your doctor. If chest pain persists for more than several minutes it is important to seek emergency care. There are other causes of chest pain, such as stomach ulcers, hiatal hernias, and pulmonary(lung) problems. It is important for many reasons to identify the cause of the pain so that proper treatment is instituted. It is always better to be safe than sorry if there is any question of whether or not the pain is cardiac in nature.
