It will be a time to reflect and prepare your heart for the celebration of Easter Sunday.

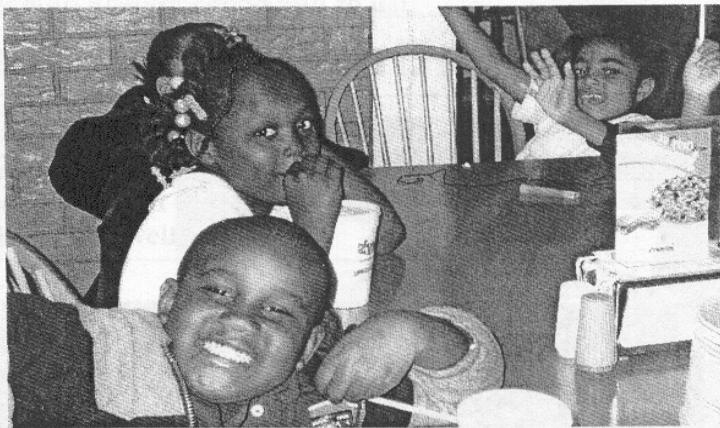

Prayer labyrinths have been around for thousands of years but more recently, they have been rediscovered as a Christian spiritual tool. Unlike a maze, a labyrinth has only one twisting path to follow to the center and then back out again. It guides you on a walking meditation or walking prayer. They are places for communing with God in the solitude of one's heart, mind and soul. Prayer labyrinths are designed so that persons move in toward the center, which symbolizes presence with God, and then move back out again to share with others. Along the way, participants pause at several stations for a guided prayer experience. Labyrinths can help a person obtain a sense of connecting with God, peace and happiness by allowing a "time-out" from the stresses of daily life.

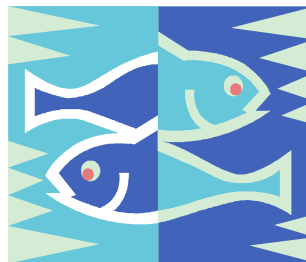


Beautiful Meeting
