Check Your Blood Pressure

During this time of blossoming flowers, it is a good time to check your blood pressure. Many of us go for long periods without checking our pressures between check-ups. This silent killer can sneak up on us without us even being aware.

Check your pressure at least once every 6 months if healthy. Check your pressure immediately if you have headache that is worse than usual or appears suddenly in the morning, unrelated to a sinus infection. If you appear to be swelling in your hands and feet or appear puffy in facial area, this may indicate that you are retaining fluid which can increase your pressure. If you have a strong family history and you do not know what your baseline pressure runs-now would be a good time to check.

Things that increase your blood pressure are increased salt intake-

Beware of canned soup. Eating out, especially fast food can cause increased sodium consumption. Non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs like Vioxx or over the counter Motrin also can contribute to rising blood pressure. If you suffer from hypertension these are things you might want to avoid. By in large, the best protection is to be a cautious patient.

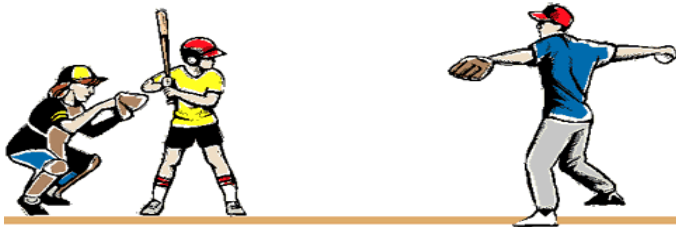

MISSION TRIP TO EL SALVADOR

Our Hispanic Ministry has the opportunity to participate in a mission trip to one of the poorest countries in Latin America, El Salvador.

The mission is going to support Shalom Children's Home. This home houses about 70 children between 1—17 years old. Shalom Home's goal is to raise needy children in their county and culture with a Christian emphasis providing education. These children can later go back into their society as professionals and make a Christian impact helping other needy children. We expect that KHCC through the Hispanic Ministry may bring blessings and support to this home. Jesus' Bolnas, one of our ministers is going on the Mission trip leaving on May 27th and returning June 3rd. If you would like to participate by donating items here is a list of what is needed: twin size bed sheets, bath towels/hand towels, hair styling gel, shampoo, hair nets for the kitchen, nude panty hose, cough syrup with expectorant, cold & flu meds, pepto bismol/imodium (generics are fine) baby wipes, diapers, diaper rash cream, vasoline, Gerber baby food, backpacks for school.
