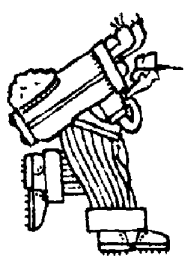

Steps needed to acquire a C.D.L. required to drive the 20 passenger Church Bus

We currently have a limited number of volunteer opportunities available to drive our new 20 passenger church bus. Please talk to Rev. Brice if you are interested in volunteering. If you would like to drive the church bus you will need to acquire a Class B Commercial Drivers License (CDL). Below you will see the requirements for getting a CDL. Along with a commercial drivers license, all drivers will be required to have a background check.

- 1.) To qualify to drive the Bus, you must have a CDL (Commercial Drivers License). This is required by law when driving a vehicle capable of transporting more than 16 passengers.**
- 2.) You can get a copy of the C.D.L. Driver Manual from the local Office of Motor Vehicles, or a copy may be available in the church office.**
- 3.) You will also need to get the required medical physical form from the Office of Motor Vehicles and get the form completed by a qualified Physician or Medical Office. (This is a 4 or 5 page form)**
- 4.) Once you have passed the Medical Physical and the long form is completed and signed by the physician, you will take the completed medical physical to the Office of Motor Vehicles. This will be done at the time you go to take the written tests.**
- 5.) For the written tests, you will need to study the appropriate sections of the C.D.L. Manual necessary to get a Class B Commercial Drivers License with passenger endorsement. The sections that need to be studied are:**

**Section 1 – Introduction
Section 2 – Driving Safety
Section 3 – Transporting Cargo Safely
Section 4 – Transporting Passengers**

- 6.) You will take 2 separate tests, General Knowledge and Passenger. You must pay \$15 at the time you go to take the test. You are allowed to retake the tests as many times as necessary to achieve a score of 80%, without paying again, within a 6 month period.**
- 7.) Once you have passed the tests, you will be given a learners permit that is required in order to take the Pre-trip Inspection and Driving Test with an authorized tester. You will also need to bring the Medical Certification Form as well as \$60 cash.**
- 8.) You will then call one of the 2 authorized testers in the Shreveport area and schedule a time to perform your Pre-trip Inspection (Section 10 in the C.D.L. manual). Once you pass the Pre-Trip inspection (it may take a couple of times) you will perform the driving test with the tester.**
- 9.) Once you have passed both the Pre-Trip inspection and the Driving Test, you will then be given a sealed envelop to take back to the Office of Motor Vehicles to complete the process and you will be issued the C.D.L. license.**

TOMATOES &



SALMONELLOSIS

The latest information from the Centers for Disease Control, on the subject of tomatoes and the salmonella outbreaks, states that consumers should avoid raw red plum, red Roma, and round red tomatoes, unless they are purchased from the sources listed at <http://www.fda.gov/oc/opacom/hottopics/tomatoes.html>.

You can continue to buy cherry, grape, tomatoes with the vine still attached, and home grown tomatoes. Texas has the largest number of cases of salmonellosis from contaminated tomatoes, with 330 known cases. Louisiana has only 1-4 cases reported.

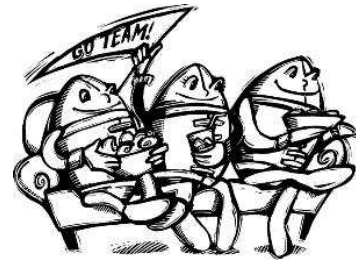

In fellowship Hall we have placed two blue containers. There is a list of items that are needed for each missionary group.

1. Is for Shreveport/Bossier Rescue Mission

Pantry items needed: Cold Cereal, grits, beans, spaghetti noodles, crackers, macaroni, tomato sauce, corn, raisins, breads and any other can goods.

Everyday items needed: Toilet paper, paper towels, rubber & surgical gloves (medium & large), liquid & bar soap, spray deodorant, combs, hair picks & brushes, bath towels, wash cloths, twin sheets, pillows, laundry detergent-powder, fabric softener, bleach, all kinds of clothing, t-shirts, pants, shorts - All sizes needed., diapers, wipes, toothbrushes - All sizes, toothpaste, shaving cream, etc.

Kitchen, Warehouse, & Office item needs: Styrofoam cups - 8 to 12 oz., styrofoam meal containers for take out, cleaning supplies, copy paper 8 1/2 X 11, pens, pencils, dry erasable markers, yellow highlighters, black markers, folders with pockets, 3-ring binders & notebooks (1/2" & 1"), 3-hole notebook paper, poster board, glue sticks, coffee, scotch & duct tape, staples - standard size, paper clips, rubber bands, trash bags - 6 to 8 gal., 13 gal., & 55 gal., motor oil - castrol 10W30, etc.

2. Is for Casa Esperanza

Pantry items needed: Dry rice, dry beans, canned goods, pasta noodles, tomato sauce, individual juice boxes, cereal, coffee, coffee cream, tea, sugar, cookies spices, etc.

Weekly pantry items needed: Ice cream, meat, chicken, bread, ham, cheese, butter, vegetables –bell peppers, tomato, onion, fruit (fresh or canned), milk, eggs, etc. (Grocery store gift cards)

Please buy small amounts or individual packages so the items do not spoil.

Everyday items needed: Toilet paper, paper towels, bath soap, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, air fresheners, clothing detergent, fabric softener, other cleaning supplies, etc.

Miscellaneous items needed: Blankets, sheets for queen and full size beds, Children, family and Christian DVD movies, etc.
