## A helpful hint from the nurse.....

Summer is the time many of us travel. When flying this summer there are a few things to consider.

Airplane travel is dehydrating, so make sure to drink plenty of fluids. During layovers be sure to drink non - caffeinated liquids, as caffeine and alcohol further dehydrate you.

Seat crowding is problematic and legroom is minimal, so make sure to stretch your legs frequently. A condition called “Deep Vein Thrombosis” or DVT can result from dehydration and limited activity. A simple exercise can prevent this. First, point your toes away from you with your leg straightened. Then reverse and stretch the toes back toward your face. Repeating this will help restore good circulation.

On Long flights it is important to stand and walk for a few minutes. Your doctor may instruct you to take baby aspirin prior to your flight to further thin your blood. Flying may not be hassle free right now, but using the proper techniques to further your health and comfort is. Have a safe summer!
