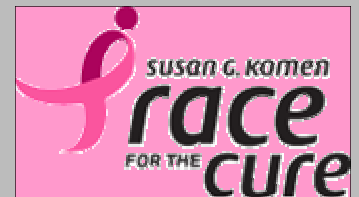

### Dr. Louis E. "Jack" Kidwell

Dr. Louis E. "Jack" Kidwell was born in Ashland, Kentucky, on September 27, 1924. He grew up in his beloved Kentucky eventually earning his Bachelor of Science in Industrial Chemistry and Master of Science in Chemistry at the University of Kentucky in Lexington. He often commented that while he was learning at UK Bobby Cook was across town at Transylvania in Lexington learning to preach – he thought that was a great coincidence! Jack went on to earn his PhD. in Chemistry at the University of Texas in Austin. From there, it was onward and upward for Jack in research and development in the chemical and petroleum industries.

He was quite an inventor with several patents to his credit not only in chemicals and petroleum, but also in the medical field. He invented, patented, manufactured and sold a protective incontinence product. After Jack's retirement from Pennzoil Co. in 1984, he became the Medical Librarian for Christus Schumpert Medical Center where he not only searched the databases for information for others but continued his tireless search for more and more knowledge.

Jack was an Eagle Scout, a member of Alpha Chi Sigma professional chemistry fraternity and Sigma Xi honorary scientific research society. He was an avid user of the computer constantly upgrading his equipment forever looking forward to the newest operating system.

Jack became an active member of Kings Highway Christian Church in 1967 where he remained until his untimely death on September 2, 2009. Though Jack had no living relatives he had a family at Kings Highway Christian Church. He spent many hours sifting through years of memorabilia to "straighten out" our Archives Room and was extremely proud of this accomplishment.

We ask that you remember Jack for his great knowledge of computers, his insatiable appetite for more knowledge, his many contributions in research and development, his quick wit and remarkable memory, his generosity and kindness, and most of all, his life long devotion to his church and his unending loyalty to his many friends and colleagues.
