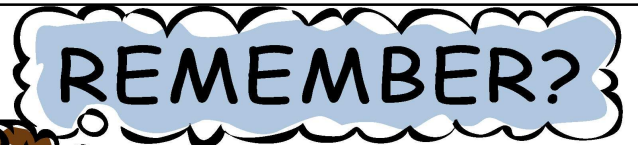

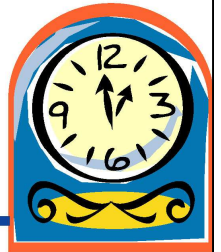

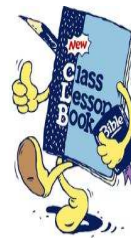

**Your Outreach Giving at Work**

Since we are well into the 4th quarter of the year, I want to take this opportunity to update you on the impact resulting from the money you have given for special offerings and budgeted outreach giving. So far this year, we have taken three special offerings:

- Week of Compassion with \$3,379.00 given
- Easter with \$2,344.00 given
- Pentecost with \$2,627.00 given

Our congregation has given a total of \$8,350.00 in special offerings in 2008 to date, which is impacting many in need. In addition to our special offerings, Outreach gives \$500.00 quarterly, which is budgeted for outreach to organizations in our local community. Week of Compassion funds provide emergency and disaster relief and other urgent humanitarian needs around the world. Half of our Easter offering went to General Ministries of Disciples of Christ, \$500.00 to Shreveport-Bossier Rescue Mission along with the \$500.00 first quarterly budgeted local outreach (\$1,000.00 total, and \$672.00) went to Volunteers of America Adoption Program. Half of the Pentecost offering went to DOC New Church Starts, \$500.00 to Caddo Council on Aging Meals on Wheels along with \$500.00 the second quarterly budgeted local outreach (\$1,000.00 total), and \$798.50 to Northwest Louisiana Interfaith Pharmacy. NW Louisiana Interfaith Pharmacy provides needed medications to individuals who have no insurance or other funding source for prescription medications needed in order to maintain employment. The third and fourth quarterly \$500.00 local outreach gifts are being given to Pool of Siloam Medical Ministry, Inc. This ministry provided medical and dental care to individuals who have no insurance or other funding for needed care. Many doctors, dentists, and other medical staff donate their time to assist this organization in providing needed services. Pool of Siloam was named as one of twelve 2008 Louisiana Heroine Award winners by the Louisiana Association of Non-profit Organizations (LANO). You can see that our congregation has given generously to make a real impact in the lives of many in our own community and throughout the world. Thank you for your generosity, and please consider giving as much as you are able to our upcoming Thanksgiving and Christmas special offerings.

Dear friends,

I would like to share the blessings that a group of 30 people from the River Valley Church, Elizabeth and I from KHCC enjoyed during our most recent mission trip to Guatemala.

Our goal on this mission trip was to bring the love of Jesus to the little children in some of the poorest communities around San Lucas. We visited two schools in the morning, and in the afternoon we stood in the middle of the small villages and called out for the children to join us in a Christian party. Besides games, surprises and snacks, we had a Bible school program for the children. We prepared Christian songs in Spanish to sing along with them and a beautiful Bible story to tell them.

The Bible Story was about Jesus when he was up in the mountains and fed 5 thousand people. We told them how after dismissing the people, Jesus went to pray alone and then he came down to the lake where the disciples were in the boat, scared because the wind was against it. The beauty about telling this story to the children is that we were in the perfect location, we were up on the hill from where we were able to see the beautiful lake of Atitlan.

Before going to Guatemala we didn't know we would be visiting these communities in the mountains around the lake of Atitlan, but the Holy Spirit knew and put into our hearts to prepare this story for the children.

Most of these children hardly have a meal a day and clothing is not something that they can change every day. We know that our visit did not solve their problems, but the smiles on their faces and the love of Jesus manifested to them through each one of those who were part of the mission trip will remain in their little hearts forever. We were like gloves on the hands of Jesus caressing the lives of all those children. They could not see Jesus physically, but they could feel him.

Fatigue was present at the end of each day, but just to think about all of those beautiful smiling faces was a great reward that renewed our strengths for the next day.

Thank you all for giving us the privilege of spreading the good news to the poor.
