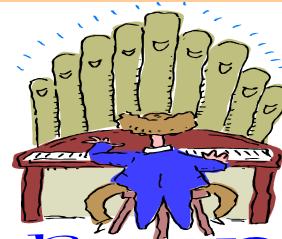
Admission is one canned food item for the food pantry.

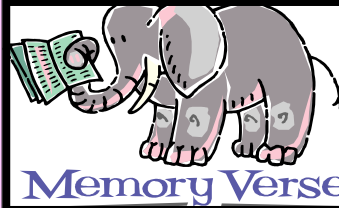

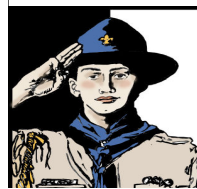
