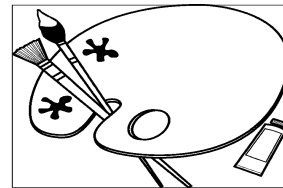

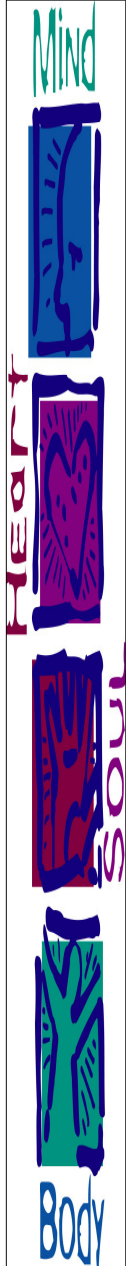

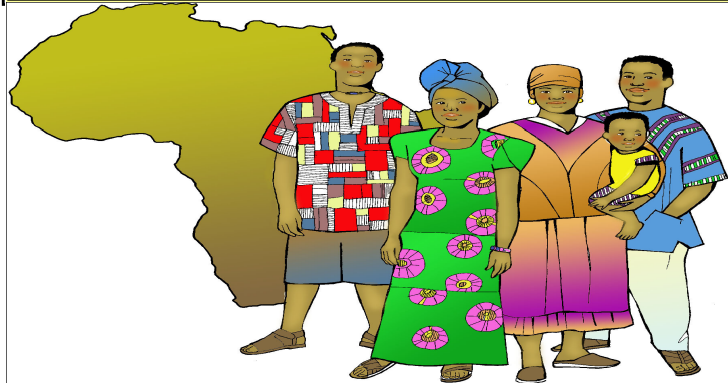

The following report is from Tim Colvin, our missionary in Africa.

This year our youth sent funds to help equip a movie house for the children and youth in the town of Wrenchville. We called this project "Operation Hollywood". Here is what Tim had to say about the results of the gifts we sent them:

"After much waiting and sorting things out, Wrenchville's movie house opened last week. About 25 children showed up on Thursday afternoon, most by word of mouth or just passing by the "Green Building" as the place has come to be known. The most exciting part was that it was free! The library is across the street from the building and we've discovered many children stay there until their parents come home from work at 5:00. So the librarian (one of our church members) was more than happy to send the children to the movies for the afternoon. We will quickly run out of room. As the days get hotter and longer, we'll probably start showing an evening movie outside."

This goes to show that our efforts here in Shreveport can make a big difference half a world away.

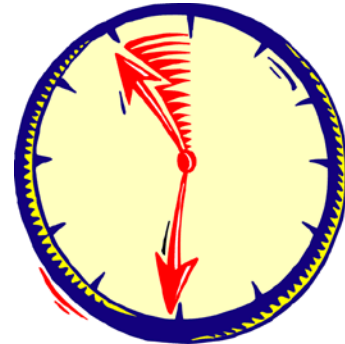
In David's sermon, he discussed Zacchaeus and how he had to come down from the tree to get close to Jesus. He spoke about how we all have trees we use as coping mechanisms, usually not healthy ones. Some of our trees might be anger, or resentment. We stay in our trees rather than risking our descent and drawing closer to God. We might feel like He couldn't forgive us or that we don't know new coping mechanisms. It can be hard to find new ways of coping when in the midst of a difficult situation.

Recently a wise friend told me what a counselor told her: we are all comfortable in our own pathology to a certain extent. What we know seems more comfortable than the unknown. The counselor said, "I may be in Hell, but at least I know the names of the Streets."

God is there to lead us through the trials of our lives, but we need to "draw near" to Him as David said Sunday morning. When we draw close to Him, he is always there for us and amazing things will happen.
