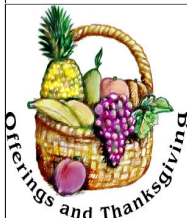

We will be presenting our Estimate of Giving cards at our worship services on November 11th where we will seek God's blessing and guidance for the use of the resources they represent.

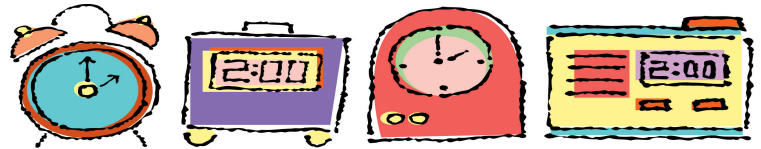
God bless you as you decide your level of support for the coming year.

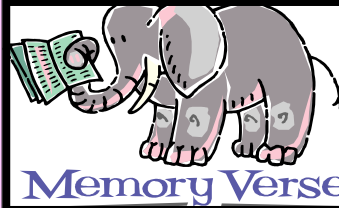
