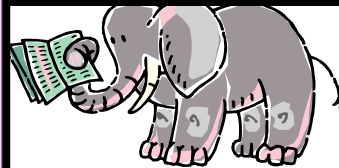

September is the time of year for Joel and Heidi Hayslip’s mission team in Burkina to begin preparing for Christmas. **GIVE A KID A CHRISTMAS** is the wonderful ministry they have done for the past 4 years. It brings the Gospel message in a vibrant and tangible way to thousands of children. Their team goes into elementary schools and into remote villages to bring a drama troupe presenting a full-gospel drama written for children. Afterward, each child is given a backpack with toys and school supplies as a tangible demonstration and reminder of God’s love. Last year they raised \$20,000 and were able to minister to 2000 children. This year their prayer is to reach 3000 children.

The Disciples Women Ministries of Kings Highway have generously donated to this ministry for the past 2 years. This year the Hayslip’s sent unique African ornaments to be used to decorate a Christmas tree.
