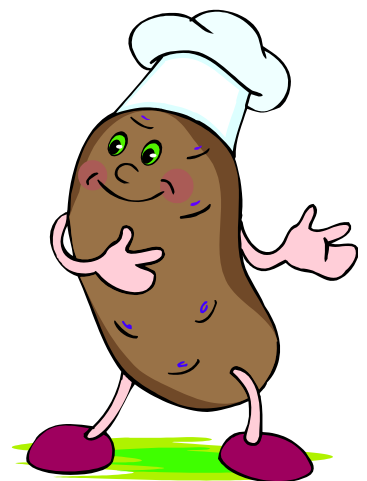

This special offering will be taken on November 14th and 21st.

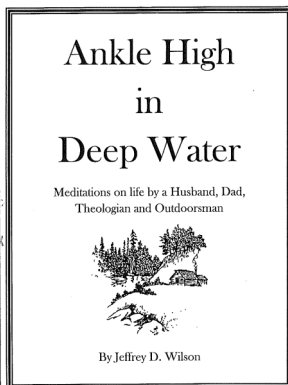

Student and campus ministry programs provide more than worship and Bible study – they welcome students to the campus community, where they find life-long friends. Students also create and join in opportunities that make them better leaders and stakeholders in the church, in the workplace, and in the community. Courses go beyond textbooks and inspire students to think about how they can change the world. Professors, instructors, and mentors focus on the student's academic progress and ethical development.

Students find life-changing opportunities to serve neighbors near campus, communities in other parts of the country, or across international borders. For students answering God's call to ministry, Disciples theological institutions challenge imaginations and sharpen the skills needed to lead and minister with congregations in the 21st Century.

The McDade House is a project of the Schumpert Medical Center and the Hospitality House of Shreveport-Bossier City, Inc., and provides a "Home-Away-from-Home," that provides hot meals, comfort, encouragement for outpatients and relatives of the seriously ill patients in our Shreveport-Bossier City hospitals. The Rescue Mission provides shelter and meals for homeless men and women, and their need for funding is ongoing. Their services become even more important with the anticipation of colder nights and days, as winter approaches. Please prayerfully consider how you will make a difference in Disciples' higher education and the individuals receiving services from these worthy local organizations.
