He lived his life with gusto; for his wife, his patients and his God most of all. Always the "right" thing was foremost in his mind. In death he was remembered as he lived his life, with a wake full of funny stories. I have never seen anyone buried in Hawaiian shirt. Our world lost a Christian force of nature, but God regained an angel. I cannot help but think Heaven is just a little more beautiful for it.

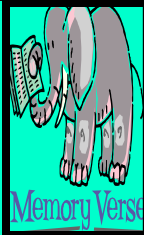

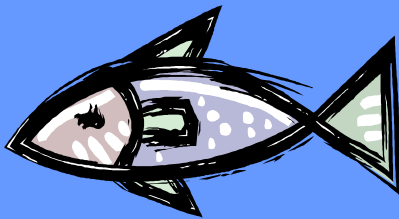

This class will cover the basics of the Christian faith and will help those interested to decide whether they want to be baptized at our combined service on Palm Sunday.

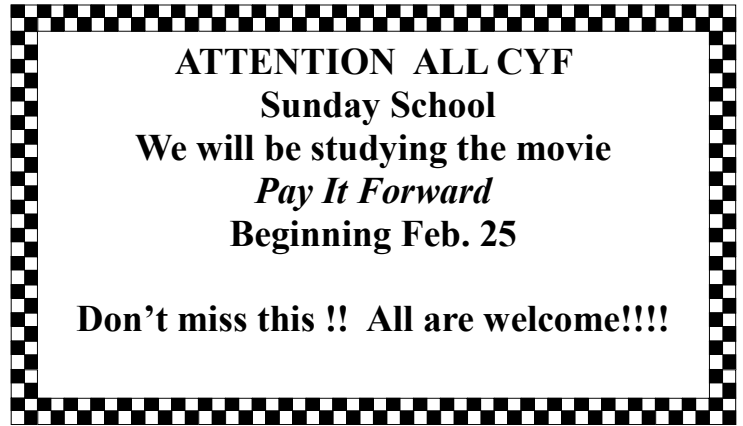
