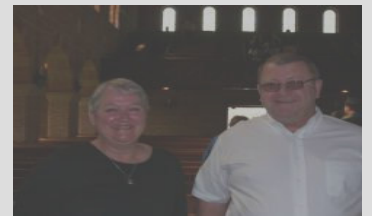

**Tips from the nurse .....**

There are things we sometimes forget that bear repeating from time to time. Children under 2 years of age should never be given honey. This may seem odd, since we feel that it is natural and wholesome, but the honey can carry infant botulism, which does not affect adults. Children under two however, can become very ill.

Children also enjoy bubble baths, especially in the summer. Many doctors prohibit or restrict bubble baths because they cause urinary tract infections. These infections may go undetected but manifest themselves as night time accidents." It should be considered when routine bubble baths are given and potty trained kids have a sudden onset of these accidents. Your pediatrician will have specific instructions on how often to allow bubbles.
