Words of encouragement. . . .

Genesis 1:27 says that we are “made in His image.” If I am to teach others those words and convince them that God is real, then I must model God’s image. I must be the person God wants me to be. I must look in the mirror every day and remind myself that I am a child of God and He gave me much when His Son, our Christ showed us the one true God.

So much happens in our lives that we often overlook this important thought – “made in His image” - given to us early in the scriptures. We put our own ideas and judgments ahead of God’s. We do not listen to God’s “still, small voice.” We get so busy that we forget to pray, to sing, to read the scriptures, or to be “Christ like.” We forget that God speaks through others as well as directly to our heart and mind.

At JYF camp this past week, we discussed daily how God is bigger than anything, but that we often fail to let God take control, regardless of His “bigness.” Our responses to events determine just how much power we receive from our God. If we fail to present ourselves as Christ presented Himself, if we fail to teach – to love – to forgive – to show mercy, then we are not living as God wants us to live. And, we do not receive the power God wants us to receive!

Our lives are so caught up in “living” – paying the house note, the utilities, the medical bills, family quarrels, and so on, that we bog down in the mundane, the matters of “living.” To “live” as God wants us to means that we put everything into His hands. Our financial difficulties, our marriage differences, our disagreements among colleagues, and our differences among friends – all goes to God! (Remember, even the Apostles disagreed!) Then, we must let go, and let God send the Holy Spirit so that we can accept God’s “bigness.” Allow the presence of the Holy Spirit by showing Christ-like actions and deeds everywhere that we go – home, work, school, fun times, and yes, even church. God would never ask for more than that from any of us. May we all remember that we are in this kingdom together, made in one image, HIS.


