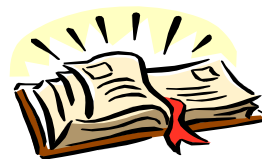
**TALL TIMBERS IS COMING!

## Stewardship - 2007

In October of 1954 Charles and I had prayerfully made the important decision to tithe. It was a scary decision. We had a two year old daughter and were expecting our second child when the job market slowed down and Charles became unemployed. Twenty-four dollars a week unemployment didn't go very far - even back in those days - and soon the money we had saved for the birth of our baby was used up. The day after Christmas Charles was called back to work and we began to catch up but after six weeks he had an emergency appendectomy and again he was unable to work.

We were most concerned about not being able to honor our church pledge. After all, we had made a promise to our church and to our Lord. Should we be embarrassed? Would we be asked to "pay up"? What should we do? We called the church office and explained our situation. The response we received was one of caring and understanding. We were told not to worry, just trust in God and everything would work out fine.

Eight weeks later Charles was back at work and we were eventually able to meet all of our obligations and by the end of that year we had honored our church pledge in full. The Lord does provide.

On Sunday, October 15<sup>th</sup> we will be asked to make our monetary pledge for the coming year. If we love God we will go to Him in prayer and seek His will as we make this important decision.
