It just goes to show that as we interact with people, there are so many things that we don't know. There may be times when actions seem so inappropriate, but they may be on the edge, looking for kindness from anyone to get through the day.

Certainly, we are not responsible for the choices that people in crisis make, and there are professionals who are very good during these critical times, however, if we treat everyone with the respect that they are entitled to as children of God, Christ's Love can shine through in ways we can't foresee.

If we take a moment at the beginning of each day to intentionally plan to treat whoever we meet with kindness and the Love of God, we can rest assured that God will use us to help heal the wounds of those around us.

The Fuller Center for Housing will conduct a "Blitz Build" from September 17th through September 21st to provide-low-income housing in the Allendale area of Shreveport.

Volunteers for building, skilled and unskilled, must be 18 years of age, complete an Emergency Contact form and a Release Waiver form, and work is from Monday through Friday 7:30 am - 4:30 pm. The registration fee is \$8 (includes t-shirt), and lunch is \$6 per day with an optional Celebration dinner at First United Methodist Friday, September 21st at \$10 each.

Volunteers to help clean and prepare the build site for the next building day must be 14 years of age, no skills needed, no forms required except registration and work is from Monday through Thursday 5:00 pm - 8:00 pm. There are no fees, meals and t-shirts will not be provided.
