A "Note" from the KHCC Music Department - Louise Chamberlain: This is a story behind some of the hymns we sing in church.

IN TIMES LIKE THESE

This meaningful and popular gospel song has been a favorite with God's people, since it was first written during the height of World War II. It was written in the midst of a busy housewife's day and came, said its author, as a direct inspiration from the Holy Spirit. Ruth Caye Jones related that all she did was write down what was given to her from God Himself. Though it was written as a response to the stresses and strains of wartime living, yet it has been used and appropriated by many of God's children for their particular difficult situations. It has been used in almost every kind of unusual pressure in the Christian life: for funerals, missionary departures, and as a source of challenge to those who are far from God and need His personal salvation. Mrs. Jones was told numerous times of the blessing that "In Times Like These" God brought to an individual at a special time of need. She also stated that she too learned first hand of the comfort and encouragement that the words of this song can provide, in difficult days, as she experienced times of convalescence, following a serious surgery.

The popularity of "In Times Like These" is evidenced by the number of ways in which the song has been arranged and published in many collections since its first appearance in 1944. It is a good example of a simple, straight-forward gospel song that God has ordained to minister to many who need periodic reminders of its vital truth.
