## FROM THE Minister

I've been the senior minister here at Kings Highway Christian Church for a good long time now, and one thing I worry about is repeating myself. I even have a little trick I use to keep from preaching on my favorite Bible verses over and over. Every Sunday I write the date in my Bible next to the verse that I'm reading from that day. There are so many wonderful scriptures to preach from, it would be a shame to repeat the same verses too often and neglect the others.

However, there are some big ideas that we can't hear too often, like the importance of showing love to one another, having faith when the way gets rough, and having hope even in the face of fear. Certainly the Bible's teachings on giving are also worth repeating. I have taught these principles many times—and Lord willing I will continue to teach them in the coming years.

What does God want us to give? We are blessed that the scriptures give us a very good idea of what God wants from us

when it comes to giving. The teachings of Jesus and the Apostle Paul tell us that we are to give regularly (weekly, monthly, or yearly; you get to decide), we are to give sacrificially (give an amount that you can feel, that makes a difference to you), we are to give proportionately (the more we have received the more we should give), and we are to give joyfully (as a response to God's love).

You may have heard these four Biblical principles of giving before but now is the time to remember them again. Please consider these principles of giving as you make decisions about your giving for the coming year. The decision you make matters; it matters to God, it matters to the church, and I hope it matters greatly to you.
