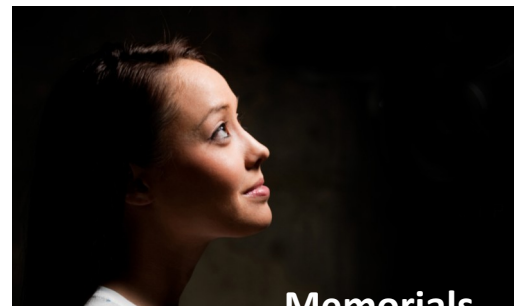

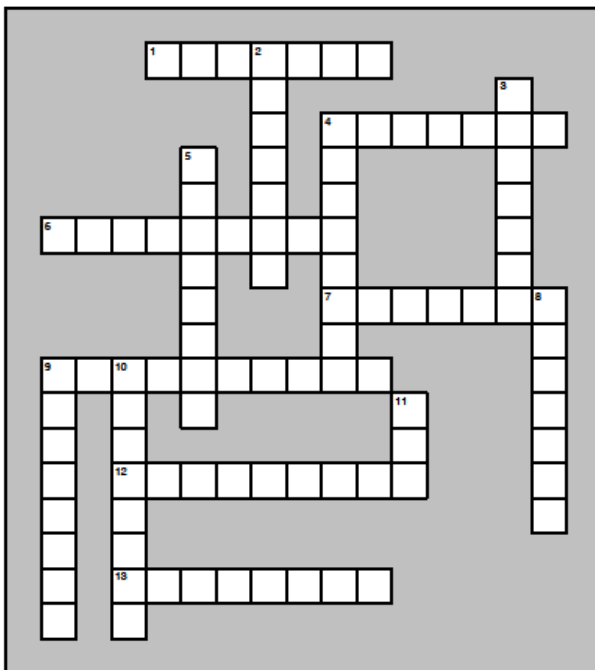

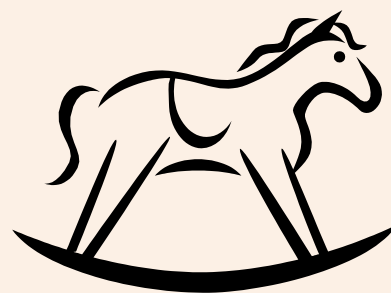

Construction on the Sanctuary stairs has begun. Sunday, November 16th the entry to Sanctuary down the stairs will be closed.

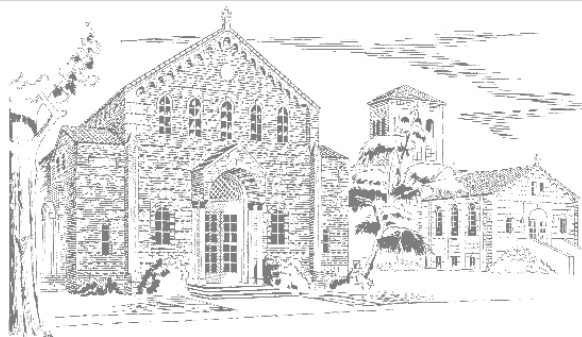
