Nominations and Nominating Committee

If you are contacted by the nominating committee during the third week of October, someone has recommended you, and we ask that you please be prepared to give their recommendation prayerful consideration.

Elder: According to our Church's By Laws.

"The Board of Elders shall have jurisdiction over the special welfare of the Church and its members: shall advise, counsel, comfort or admonish; shall serve the Lord's Table; shall be responsible for the public worship service of the Church, the supply of the pulpit, the form and manner of the administration of the sacraments of baptism and communion; and shall perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Official Board."

- Serve communion to the hospitalized and homebound.
- Serve as the spiritual leaders of the church.
- Meet each Monday morning to discuss and pray for the needs of the members of the congregation.
- Provide counsel to the senior minister and board chair particularly in matters relating to worship, evangelism, and pastoral care.
