Board Chairman Synopsis Monday, March 21, 2016

Everyone was happy that we got the January Board Minutes early. Getting the Minutes to the Board early gives everyone a chance to study them in the event we needed to make corrections. We had two corrections to the January Minutes and they were approved as corrected.

Mike gave the treasurers report and stated that February was a decent month. We were \$5,600 short of budget, because expenses were greater than revenue. We are at this point \$2,200 short of our budgeted figure. Mike stated that we paid \$95,000 toward our Mortgage in 2015. Our Pledges are a little behind and we would really encourage our Congregation to stay on top of their pledges.

Renee wanted to thank Becky Flippo, Doll Burk and Jessie Matthews for the help in having a successful Palm Sunday lunch. Also big thanks to the Pathfinders SS Class for helping serve and all the wonderful cakes brought by our SS Classes. We served over 200 people and cleared \$459 after expenses to be used to help fund future activities. The children and adults had a great time at our skate night, many to follow. It would be nice if we could get Skate Night in a rotation of Sunday School Classes and also slip in a little Bible study. Our Dinners coming up in May are Cinco De Mayo and the Church's Birthday May 22nd.

Allen Swilley gave the Outreach report and went over the Outreach Yearly Budget and how they are distributed.

Evangelism report was given by Robert Asher. The Committee discussed promoting the Church by word of mouth and Facebook ads. They also discussed ideas for bringing in new people to KHCC including proposals for a Movie Night, Mini-Golf and a week night Bible Study. Evangelism is actively running three ads on Google; including ads combined have approximately 200 views for the month of March. Robert discussed Amazon Smile and will explain to the Congregation at a later date. The Church will send out instructions on how to use.

Dennis Murray discussed the Church Work Day on Saturday April 23rd from 8:00am until noon at the Old McGuire property as a Beautification project. More information will come in the Church Newsletter. We are trying to make the Family Life Center accessible with a card, but we need to purchase a new Panic Bar for the front door to make this possible. We are in the process of making this happen at this time.

Senior Minister David Brice stated that the call is closer to getting the Worship Committee organized. Several members have expressed an interest in being part of the Ministry. The Team will be split up into Traditional and Contemporary so that it will be less work on each member of the Ministry.

Glenda Davis gave the DWM Report. The KHCC Ladies Spring Retreat was held March 5, 2016, with 23 ladies from Kings Highway registered. Christa Pazzaglia from Hope Connection on Levy Street was the guest speaker. Hospitality House will soon move their operation to Hope Connection where they will serve two meals a day. Hope has five licensed counselors on staff. Joy Fellowship and DWM Executive Board Meeting will be held on March 28. The next important date for all ladies is the GRR Disciples Women's Spring Workshop on April 22, 2016, registration at 12:00 noon with a salad potluck luncheon. Among other things, plans will be discussed for the Louisiana Retreat "One River...Many Connections" to be held at the Wesley Center, Woodworth, Louisiana, October 14-16, 2016.

Associate Minister Eli Bulnes gave the Staff Report. Eli will deliver the sermon in both services on April 3rd, 2016. So far this year, Eli had the blessing of visiting church members who had surgeries in the hospital. Eli stated that the DWM gave her the blessing of presiding over the Lord's Table at the Ladies' Retreat. So far this year we have provided a home for 3 families at Casa Esperanza. There are currently two families staying at Casa Esperanza. The House is booked until June 2016. ESL classes started February 29th, 43 people are attending this season.

Becky Flippo, Youth Director stated Youth Sunday was March 6th with CYF and Chi Rho providing worship along with special music from the Bell Choir, Youth Rock, Kidz Rock and Emma Thomas. Senior Haley Kirton delivered a short message followed by a supporting skit. Chi Rho filled Easter Eggs and CYF hid them for the Easter Egg Hunt. Camp Registration will be on Sunday, April 10th in the Fellowship Hall for JYF, Chi Rho and CYF summer camps, during the same time as Meet and Greet. CYF will have a rummage sale on Saturday, April 30th in the Family Life Center. Anyone having items to be picked up is asked to call the Church or Becky.

Senior Minister David Brice expressed everyone's excitement for the Palm Sunday Combined Worship Service, the well attended All Church Lunch and the Fantastic Easter Egg Hunt. We had a Celebration in that 7 young people were Baptized, 3 affirmations of faith and 7 babies in the nursery, it's been a long time since we have had this many children involved in Church activities. We need to really recognize and give thanks that our Church is growing through its youth. David stated that 18 children and adults went to Snoasis, this is our Youth Program and this should be celebrated. He can remember at least one occasion in the past that we had only two youth participating in the service on Youth Sunday. When someone asks you about our Youth Program, you should say that it is fantastic. We had over 20 youths participating in Youth Sunday, March 6th and they did a superb job. He stated that he would rather be here than anywhere else and that we should all be grateful to be where we are, as we have much to celebrate.

Board Chair, Bobby Shields presented additional items for information. The first is the Beautification Project for the old McGuire house property. There will be an all-church work day on Saturday, April 23, from 8:00am to 12:00 noon, with Hamburgers and Hot Dogs served at noon. It was stated in discussion that some of the members of the Pioneer Class plan to bring power washers and power wash the Church at the same time. Due to many leaks in the buildings, please check with Property Chair, Dennis Murray before beginning any of this kind of work. There will be more information to follow on this project. Bobby is looking into ways that the church may be of service during floods or disasters. We do not need to reinvent the wheel, just find out how we can be of help.

Under Items for action, Barry Eakin was asked to report on the tabled item regarding establishment of a church Security Team. He provided and read a proposal which he put together after researching the topic and talking with a number of people. For a church of our size, it is recommended that we should have six regular team members, as well as three alternate volunteers. Barry stated that there are about four members who have either past or current law enforcement backgrounds, who would make good team members. David Brice moved that Barry assemble a group to write a security policy, which can be reviewed and presented to the Board for recommendations and/or approval. Mike Corkran seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Also under Items for Action, Christian Education has requested approval of \$700 for gas money to transport youth to camps this summer. Renee Eakin made a motion, Bobby Shields seconded and it was unanimously approved.

Also under Items for Action, Property Chair, Dennis Murray made a motion to spend \$12,518.00 to replace the small flat roof over the equipment room behind the baptistery; motion was seconded by Clint Snell and unanimously approved.
