**Back and Forth to Burkina:** It's been several months since Joel has traveled to Burkina, so we are very excited that Operation Christmas Child has asked Joel to be a part of a church-planting strategy they are developing among an unreached people there. He'll stay there an extra week to meet with the team there and develop some new strategies for evangelism. *Please pray for his trip the first couple weeks of August.* 

**Coming to America:** Desire Nana is a young man of God that we have been mentoring and training for many years, and who has been faithfully working with our evangelism teams and leading a successful kids club in his neighborhood. We are so excited that he has been accepted into Victory Bible College here in Tulsa! *We ask you to pray for his interview at the American Embassy so he can get his visa.* 

Writing a Book: Since the trip to Thailand, Joel has been busy writing a book. It is a series of stories from Burkina as well as life lessons they taught us. We felt that it was important to get these on paper, and our hope is to develop a curriculum based on the book that Joel can teach to children pastors.

**Family News:** Jakob is in summer school and Silas is attending a summer day camp. Both are doing well and catching up in their schooling. Heidi is enjoying actually having a garden instead of dry dirt in the yard (in Burkina) and is catching up on house projects over the summer. Because of budget cuts she lost her job at the elementary school along with many other people. Please pray she can find another great job soon.
