FRIDAY, THE THIRD WEEK OF LENT PSALM 101:INTEGRITY

I will walk with integrity of heart within my house, PSALM 101:2-3

Early Bird Registration deadline is April 1, 2018, and will save you about \$30 but Cancellation fees might be more, so make sure your child is going.

Regular Registration Deadline is May 1, 2018 Grand Camp – For children 4 - 10 yrs. old and at least one Grandparent June 1 – 3; 170 each

Chi Rho Camp – Grades 6 - 7 June 11 – 16; \$375

CYF Conference - Grades 10 - 12 June 18 - 23; \$390
