FRIDAY, THE FOURTH WEEK OF LENT **REPENTANCE: PSALM 32**

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go;

*I will counsel you with my eye upon you. **PSALM 32:8***

We've all had the experience of needing to reverse direction, only to be utterly frustrated by that sign with the big red slash telling us "No U-turns allowed." The exact opposite is true when it comes to repentance--U-turns *are* allowed.

Plainly and simply, to repent means to stop in our tracks and turn in a new direction. It means reversing direction from our own sinful, selfish interests toward lives marked by the redemption that is ours in Christ. Make no mistake, however; living lives of repentance isn't easy. We need Christ.

Camp Registration: KHCC will be paying 1/2 of the registration fee.

How do I register?

1) Go to DISCIPLESCROSSING.CAMPBRAINREGISTRATION.COM 2) As soon as you register, please notify the Church Office at 222-3684 that you have done so.

Early Bird Registration deadline is April 1, 2018, and will save you about \$30 but Cancellation fees might be more, so make sure your child is going.

Regular Registration Deadline is May 1, 2018

Grand Camp – For children 4 - 10 yrs. old and at least one Grandparent June 1 – 3; \$170 each

Chi Rho Camp – Grades 6 - 7 June 11 – 16; \$375

CYF Conference – Grades 10 - 12 June 18 – 23; \$390

Niner's Camp – Youth who have just completed 9th Grade June 18 – 23; \$390

Eigher's Camp – Youth who have just completed 8th Grade June 24 – 30; \$440

JYF Camp – Grades 3 – 5 ***Please note this camp is during 4th of July holiday July 2 – 6; \$315

Late registration includes anyone registering between May 1st and May 15th. There will be no registrations after May 15th. Please note the fee increases \$40 per person. Since KHCC will only be paying 1/2 of the original registration fee, the additional \$40 fee will be the responsibility of the parents.

Since KHCC is paying 1/2 of the registration fee for each youth attending camp this summer, please choose the computer option in CampBrain that your home church will pay the registration fee and then pay KHCC by check 1/2 of the registration fee. Disciples Crossing will then send the church the invoice for all camp registrants.
