GOOD FRIDAY RIGHTEOUSNESS: PSALM 71

In your righteousness deliver me and rescue me; incline your ear to me, and save me. **PSALM 71:2**

Righteousness. The act of returning something to its original--right--state.

There are so many things that happened on Good Friday. Jesus scorned and beaten, carrying the cross to Golgotha. The shame of our sins being nailed to the cross. His last words; his final breath.

One often overlooked is the moment the curtain in the temple was torn in two. The curtain, this veil, separated the Holy of Holies--the earthly dwelling place of God's presence--from the rest of the temple. Only once a year could the high priest come into God's presence to make an offering in payment for the sins of God's people. This curtain, this veil, showed that we had been separated from God by our sin.

Now through the death of Jesus, our Great High Priest, we have been brought back into a right relationship with God; we have been made righteous. With the psalmist, we plead for deliverance.

Crucified and risen Savior, in your righteousness, deliver me and rescue me. Amen.
