RECIPIENT STORY - LAUREN EDWARDS



Hey y'all, my name is Lauren Edwards! About one year ago I was involved in a car accident that led to many injuries, three months in the hospital and many physical and occupational therapy appointments that lasted several months after being discharged from the hospital. Some of the injuries that I received because of my accident were a traumatic brain injury, skull fracture, broken nose, broken femur, a broken jaw (in 3 places), and I lost all vision in my left eye due to nerve damage.

When the firemen and paramedics extricated me from my car, I was immediately air lifted to LSU Med Center in Shreveport.

While in the hospital I was given countless blood transfusions, that helped save my life. Without those blood transfusions, it would have been impossible for me to survive. Before my accident I always wanted to donate but I never really had the opportunity to. When I saw the LifeShare bus on the Northwestern State University campus I didn't even think twice about donating. I wanted to be one of the people who helped contribute to saving someone else's life, just like the many people that donated and helped save my life! **So, I encourage you to go donate today!**

How do I register?

Early Bird Registration deadline is April 1, 2018, and will save you about \$30 but Cancellation fees might be more, so make sure your child is going.

Regular Registration Deadline is May 1, 2018

Grand Camp – For children 4 - 10 yrs. old and at least one Grandparent June 1 – 3; \$170 each

Chi Rho Camp – Grades 6 - 7 June 11 – 16; \$375

CYF Conference – Grades 10 - 12 June 18 – 23; \$390

Niner's Camp – Youth who have just completed 9th Grade June 18 – 23; \$390

Eighther's Camp – Youth who have just completed 8th Grade June 24 – 30; \$440

JYF Camp – Grades 3 – 5 ***Please note this camp is during 4th of July holiday July 2 – 6; \$315

Late registration includes anyone registering between May 1st and May 15th. There will be no registrations after May 15th. Please note the fee increases \$40 per person. Since KHCC will only be paying 1/2 of the original registration fee, the additional \$40 fee will be the responsibility of the

parents.

Since KHCC is paying 1/2 of the registration fee for each youth attending camp this summer, please choose the computer option in CampBrain that your home church will pay the registration fee and then pay KHCC by check 1/2 of the registration fee.
