What is the mission of Patterns for Patients?

Patterns for Patients' mission is to collect fabric for Shriners Hospitals for Children Orthotic and Prosthetic department. This fabric helps children have the opportunity to choose a pattern for their new prosthetic limb even if their family does not have the means to do so. The material SHOULDN'T be stretchy or furry, but SHOULD be the same material as most pillow cases and not have much give to it. Below are some examples of how donated fabrics will be incorporated into a child's new prosthetic limb.
