Report from the Official Board meeting of July 15

25 members and guests were present for the meeting.

The Treasurer's report showed that from January through June overall income was 5% over budget (although contributions to the Capital fund were down) and that, other than Property, expenses were under budget. However, the failure of several vital mechanical

and HVAC systems put Property spending at \$39,000 over budget, and resulted in an overall deficit of \$35,338 for this year.

Written reports were also received from the Secretary, Outreach, Property, Trustees, and the Interim Sr., Associate, and Hispanic ministers.

Outreach reported great responses to the special offerings, blood drive, and gift of items for the Noel Food Pantry. Conversations continue concerning a possible new location for the Highland Dinner and Highland Ministries.

Property reported that insurance coverage for storm damage continues to be in dispute. Storm damage repairs to Casa Esperanza has been completed. The water heater for the Educational building was leaking and has been replaced. We are switching phone and internet providers (cost effective) and new cabling is being installed. The office and Casa Esperanza HVAC units were both old and not holding freon, and had to be replaced. After some recent vandalism, additional security cameras are being installed. Termite damage in the boiler room necessitated repair of the wooden box supporting an AC unit, and a termite treatment was completed. The FLC refrigerator and the kitchen dishwasher were repaired. We have changed vendors of janitorial supplies and new towel and soap dispensers have been installed. A group of members has offered to donate monies for re-striping the Sanctuary parking lot.

Robert Dickinson has resigned as a Trustee. The Board expressed their heartfelt thanks for Robert's expertise and many years of service as a Trustee. The Trustees are pursuing further action on the insurance claim.

The Interim Sr. Minister presented two items for the Board to review before the next meeting: the document "Ethical Guidelines for Congregational Conduct" and a rationale for developing a Safety and Security Team and a sample safety plan for KHCC (including addressing such emergencies and dangerous weather, disruptive people, fires, medical emergencies, etc.)

Other business.

- A discussion of revised By-Laws was tabled.
- Re-striping the Sanctuary lot was approved.
- The Board affirmed the actions of the Executive in replacing and repairing the broken systems.
- A bid of \$12,000 to repair and repaint the exterior of the sanctuary windows was approved (the contractor has subsequently withdrawn that bid, so this project is on hold.)

These last few weeks have been hard on our church budget. Some broken windows from vandalism has required repairs and the installation of additional security cameras. Two old HVAC systems went down and had to be replaced, as did an old water heater and sump pump. We see the AC repair people a good bit during the summer. We have a lot of mechanical systems here at KHCC, and eventually they will all break - but we hope not all at once (and the Parlor HVAC had already been replaced this year.)

The good news - thanks to Dennis Murray (our experienced and knowledgeable Property Chair), Rick and Russell Elliot, Bill Miley, Mike Bradford, Donnie West, Larry Bell, and the staff - we have kept these costs to a minimum. A lot of volunteer time has been given to keep the building beautiful, safe, and comfortable.
