Scripture is full of accounts of prophets who were great disrupters of tradition, and who didn't hesitate to speak up when they saw traditions ignored (traditions of justice, benevolence) or held without reason (nitpicky rules that oppressed or discourage.) Sometimes it takes the judgement of another to know. Like about the shoes.
