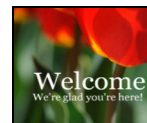



A “Note” from the KHCC Music Department

PRECIOUS LORD, TAKE MY HAND



Many of you have asked me about this hymn. Tommy Dorsey, the big band leader didn't write this beautiful hymn. It was written by Thomas A. Dorsey, who was a black gospel musician. He was born in 1899, and grew up in a Christian home in Georgia. His father was an itinerant preacher. By the time he was ten or twelve, he had learned to play the organ. As a preacher's kid, he was exposed to quite a bit of religious activity, however he didn't follow it.

Thomas put a band together and traveled around quite a bit. He wrote over 150 blues songs, and some are popular yet. But Thomas Dorsey could never forget the influence of his early religious training or the memory of his godly parents. Even when busily playing in bars and clubs around the country, he still thought a great deal about his early life. In spite of many harrowing experiences and brushes with death, God always spared his life. As a young man in his twenties, Dorsey began to reflect seriously about himself, how God had preserved him on so many occasions and that he was now foolishly wasting his time and talents.

For the next few years, Thomas Dorsey was actively involved in singing for church services and writing gospel songs. However while ministering in a revival meeting in St. Louis, Missouri, he received a telegram informing him that his wife, Nettie, had just died suddenly while delivering their first child. Arriving home in South Chicago that same night, he was met with the further news that his infant son had also died. The sorrow was more than Dorsey could bear. He felt like God had treated him wrong.

A few weeks later he was sitting with a friend, Theodore Frye, the gospel singer, trying to get over his grief. He sat down at the piano and began playing this song, except he called it Blessed Lord. His friend told him the words were good, but he didn't like “Blessed Lord.” He suggested that Dorsey call it “Precious Lord, take my hand.” It was first sung at the Ebenezer Baptist Church. He went on to write 250 gospel songs, including “Peace in the Valley.” He died in 1965.

The words to this hymn are on page 628 of the Chalice Hymnal, but for those of you who don't have access to it, I will write the words here.

Precious Lord, Take my hand, lead me on, let me stand, I am tired, I am weak, I am worn. Through the storm, through the night, lead me on to the light Take my hand, precious Lord, Lead me home.

When my way grows drear, precious Lord, linger near, when my life is almost gone. Hear my cry, hear my call, hold my hand lest I fall. Take my hand, precious Lord, lead me home

When the darkness appears and the night draws near, and the day is past and gone, At the river I stand, guide my feet, hold my hand. Take my hand, precious Lord, lead me home.

Dear Church Family,

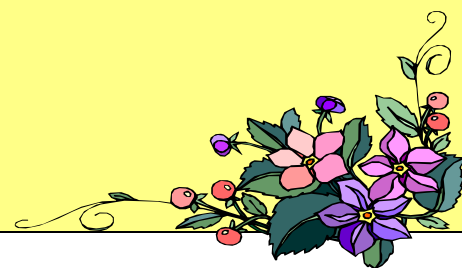
The whole Moore family wants to thank you all for your many expressions of God's love during Joe's recent illness, hospitalization and passing.
