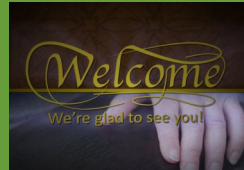

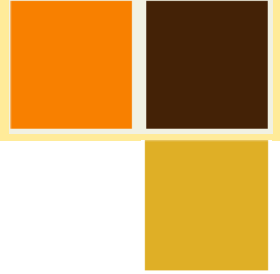

The History of Tithing

Part 2

As we learned last week, for the first two thousand years or so of human history there were limited instances of tithing described in the Bible. Examples include free will offerings of Abraham and Jacob along with Moses in early Exodus requiring free will contributions from the Israelites. As time went on, Moses saw the need for a law on tithing to help Israel prosper. The tithe was incorporated into Mosaic law and it included a percent of what you owned such as fruit trees, crops and livestock. Under this law, Moses taught it was Israel's moral obligation to tithe in order for God to bless the work of the people. However, nowhere in the law was tithing based on income.

Each time the word tithe is mentioned in the New Testament, it is referenced to the Old Testament law the Israelites were under. As the new covenant came into being, the traditional sense of tithing was no longer a part of the law.

New Covenant Christians do not have to tithe to please God. Walking in one's faith brings blessing, for obedience and servanthood are what God desires. As believers, we receive blessing because we are under grace. The Intention of our heart is what God is looking at more than the amount we give. The spirit of the New Testament tells us that Christians should not be coerced to tithe. The New Testament calls on us to give proportionally, sacrificially, and regularly. In other words, our stewardship should be based on how much resources we have, giving an amount that makes a real difference to you, and on a regular basis. Truly the amount is between you and God. With the right mindset, based on the Word of God and a heart that flows with gratitude for what He has done for you, we should want to give all that we are able to do.

I call you to study the Bible to see for yourself what God requires of you. As for my family and me, we will give all we can in time, talents, and money for His glory and the good of our church.

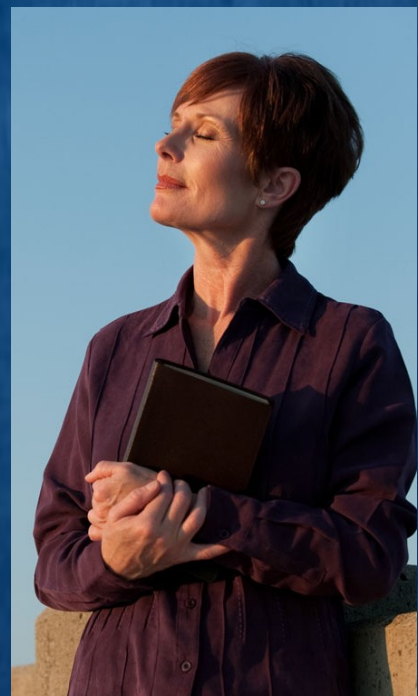
