



# "Meet Our Guests At Casa Esperanza"

This is Emilee Flores & her mom Betty Flores from Honduras. They have been staying at Casa Esperanza since March this year. This is not their first time at Shriners Hospital for Children; Emilee has received treatments since she was 6 years old. This is their second time at Casa Esperanza- it's nice to welcome them back. The first time they stayed with us was four years ago.

It's nice to see how Emilee has grown, now she is a pretty sixteen years old girl. She is a very smart student as well. Everyone misses her at her school in the Capital city Tegucigalpa where she is in 10<sup>th</sup> grade. She loves to listen to music, chat online with her classmates and watch cartoons. She is busy doing her schoolwork while she's here, so she'll be on track when she returns home.



They arrived in the US on February 14<sup>th</sup> and a few days later Emilee had her main surgery to enlarge her right leg. This is a long and painful treatment that will take between 8 to 9 months. Being away from home for so long is not pleasant news for them both (you should see their faces when they talk about it), but their faces shine again when they think that at least they are staying at Casa Esperanza.

"Sometimes we feel homesick, but then we realize that it is a blessing to live in this beautiful and spacious house that makes us feel like we are home. It is nice to have a church to attend to and people like you who support us in many ways." Betty said.

I hope you enjoy getting to know this great family, especially since they will be a part of our ministry for several months this year.
