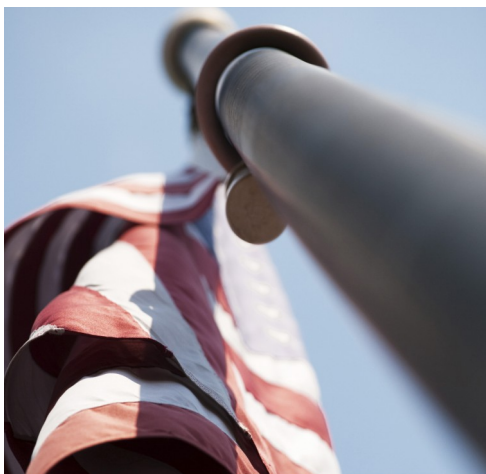

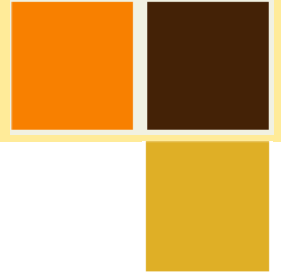

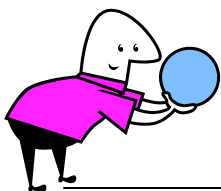
Chi Rho Kick-Off Party September 15th, 12:15–2:30 pm

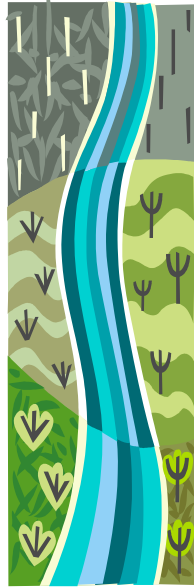
