## *From the Minister. . . .*

Last Sunday, in my sermon, I talked about the value of gratitude and how important it is for us to be aware of our many blessings. It didn't take long for me to find something here at the church to be grateful for. Later that same day I attended our church's Sunday afternoon activities for children and youth and I was so happy to see over 25 of our kids in attendance. These young people were split among the 4 age groups (FWF for k-2<sup>nd</sup> grade, JYF for 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>, Chi Rho for 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, and CYF for 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>) that have regular meetings each Sunday, as were the nine adult sponsors who were leading these groups. Also present was our wonderful youth director, Becky Flippo. Becky and her husband Joey have been members of KHCC for decades, and as youth director, Becky has been a part-time member of the church staff for the last five years (though she works like she's full-time).

At our Sunday afternoon activities our kids get a chance to fellowship, study the Bible, and have lots of fun. During their time in our youth groups the kids will also have the chance to attend church camp and other youth events with our regional church, take mission trips around our area and around the country, participate in singing groups, bands and orchestra groups, have fun parties at the beginning and end of the year (and during the year too), complete service projects for our church, and raise money for their outreach projects by hosting dinners and having other fundraising events.

How can you support our children and youth groups? First, by keeping them in your prayers. Pray for our kids, our sponsors, and our youth director. Second, support the projects that they undertake by attending their fundraisers. Third, consider getting your feet wet as a sponsor or Sunday school teacher by volunteering to substitute when one of our regular sponsors is out. You will need to have a background check and fill out some paperwork in order to qualify for this volunteer opportunity but it gives us a great opportunity to see if you have the right stuff to work with our youth.

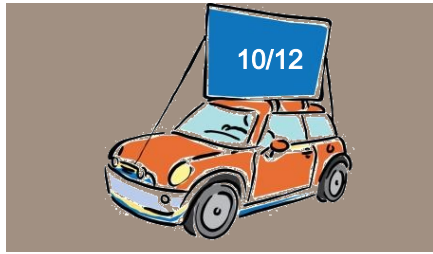
## KHCC Nominations
