From the Minister....

There have been a couple of important anniversaries that have gone unrecognized over the last few months here at the church. In July it was the ninth anniversary of Ellie and Jesus Bulnes coming to work here at KHCC. This month is the ninth anniversary of the beginning of our ministry to the Hispanic community. And October 7th was Ellie's birthday.

To better understand the early history of our ministry to the Hispanic community I have written this timeline. I hope you find it interesting, and I hope it reminds you of what a blessing the Bulnes family and their ministry have been to our church over the last nine years.

July, 2004 – The Reverends Jesus and Ellie Bulnes are called by KHCC to start a new ministry to the Hispanic community here in Shreveport.

August, 2004 – The first English classes are sponsored by our ministry to the Hispanic community. Over the last nine years these English classes have served hundreds of students.

October, 2004 – After several months of preparation the ministry to the Hispanic community officially begins.

September, 2005 – Rev. David Brice is installed as senior minster at KHCC and begins working with Jesus, Ellie, the church's congregation, and board to develop a plan for the future of the Hispanic Ministry at KHCC.

January, 2006 – The church board clarifies the role of the ministry to the Hispanic community and declares it an ongoing ministry of KHCC. Hispanic members of this ministry are recognized as also being members of our church. The ministry is added to our church's budget.

November, 2006 – Esther and Edwardo Navaro become the first family to stay at the church's house on the corner of Kings Hwy and Thornhill while Edwardo receives treatments at Shriners Hospital.

July, 2007 - Casa Esperanza becomes a ministry of KHCC, housing families of international patients at Shriners Hospital.

September 2007 – Expiration of their visa and delays in processing their application for a green card leave the Bulnes family preparing to return to Honduras.

December, 2007 - At the 11th hour the Bulnes family's application is approved and they are able to stay in the U.S.A. and continue working at Kings Highway Christian Church.

August, 2008 – Ellie Bulnes is installed as KHCC's associate minister. Jesus Bulnes takes on sole leadership of our ministry to the Hispanic community.






