Over the last few weeks I've spent a lot of my free time working around my house. After all these years I still haven't gotten used to how much time it takes to keep everything around the old homestead repaired and running smoothly. Last week I was watching TV in our family room when water started dripping from the ceiling. "There's another item for my to-do list," I thought, and got up to investigate the source of the drip. Making repairs takes a lot of my time and paying the houses' bills and mortgage takes a lot of our money. Owning a house isn't easy, but the rewards definitely outweigh the challenges.

What's true at home is certainly true here at the church, but more so because here at the church there is so much more to do. Lots to do means lots of bills coming in and then there's also the \$6,111.54 we pay each month to cover our mortgage here at the church. Most of the major repairs at the church, like the new roof for one of our buildings, and the mortgage are paid for out of our God's House Fund. In the weeks ahead you will have the opportunity to make a pledge to this fund and help the church to pay the mortgage in the year to come and save for our next big repair job.

Of course, we also need to make a pledge to our General Fund. This fund pays the monthly bills, pays the staff's salaries, and pays for our programs here at the church. I hope that you will be able to make a pledge to the general fund this year and I pray that it can be equal to or greater than the pledge you made last year. We are one church with two financial needs. I hope that you will prayerfully consider how you will help the church to meet these needs in the coming year as you make out your pledge.

Giving to your Church: My thoughts by Robert W. (Bill) Shield, Jr.

I have learned that we are blessed when we give back to God. Even though most of our giving goes to the church, we don't give to a church and we don't give to Dr. Brice. We give our offerings to God. We have faith that our offering will be used to the glory of God and God's people. The Bible teaches us to give from a cheerful heart, for our own good and for our own blessings. I, and I hope you, look forward every week to putting that little white envelope in the collection plate as much as you do participating in Communion. Both are integral to belonging to a flourishing Disciples of Christ church.

In all the years I've been a member of KHCC, two sermons have resonated the most with me. The first was a sermon given by Dr. Dave that dealt with what it means to be an American. As a retired Air Force officer I have seen how other nationalities have to live, and I count my blessings. The other sermon was given earlier this month on "Three reasons every day to be grateful." As you can see, both sermons have a lot in common. We are God's chosen people and He has blessed us with His Grace because we have put Him first in our lives. To show our love for God we give back according to our ability.

Giving is discussed in both Testaments, however my two favorites are from 2 Corinthians 9:7: "Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." The other verse is from Acts 20:35: "In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus Himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than receive.'"
