From the Minister....

Early this year the board approved a budget for our church of \$589,385 for 2013. That is how much we planed to receive this year in offerings and other income, and it is how much we have planned to spend to support the ministries of our church. You may wonder where all this money goes. To better answer this question I have put together the following breakdown of how our gifts to the church are used.

The numbers in the box are the percentages of our total budget that we have dedicated to the different ministries of our church. percentage is based on the budgets for those ministries plus the salaries of those working exclusively in each ministry. For instance, the percentage we have budgeted for property includes the salaries of our two custodians, and the percentage for education includes the salaries of our nursery workers and youth director. My salary and the salary of the associate minister and church secretary are included on the Administrative and Ministerial line since we work with all the ministries of the church.

This is how our gifts to the general fund are being used in 2013. But please remember we are one church with two needs. In addition to the general expenses listed above, we also have to pay for God's house. Every month the church makes a \$6,111.54 loan payment. We also need to put some money away for future major repairs to our facilities. The money that you set aside to give to the God's house fund will cover these expenses.

I hope this is helpful information as you prayerfully consider the amount of your gift to the church in the coming year. I also hope this information will help to prepare us to set our budget for 2014. Commitment Sunday is just a few days away and after that our Church Treasurer and our Finance Committee will get to work on a 2014 budget to propose to the board. Please do let us know by phone, email or in person if you have a suggestion on how we can better allocate our funds for the coming year.




