Special Opportunity to Make a Contribution to the Church

If you are over 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ and have an IRA (or other retirement plan) and you are required to take an RMD (Required Minimum Distribution) you still have the opportunity to do so and specifically direct the funds to the church. As you may know, if you are supposed to take an RMD from your retirement plan and don't you may be facing a penalty of 50%. An alternative to taking the RMD directly is to direct it to the church. You will have satisfied the requirement of taking the RMD without having to recognize the income. However, because you didn't recognize the income, you cannot deduct the contribution. This particular opportunity is limited to \$100,000 per year, or any amount that will help you satisfy the distribution requirement.
