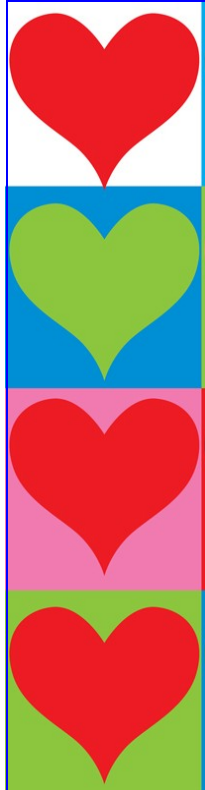

“One Church: Two Needs” Stewardship Campaign Report

Dear Members and Friends of KHCC:

First, I would like to thank each and everyone that contributed to the Stewardship Campaign, One Church: Two Needs. We have created a budget using your Pledges that make it possible for us to prepare for our ministries in the coming year.

We are excited to report that we have exceeded our goal for the God's House Fund by \$19,000 for the coming year. These monies will make it possible for us to pay our monthly mortgage and enable us to save for major repairs and upgrades to our buildings and grounds. Since we have no choice of whether or not to make our mortgage payment each month, we are happy to know that this expense is more than covered by the pledges.

Our General Fund Pledges are down significantly for 2014 and we anticipate receiving approximately \$45,000 less. The Finance Committee and Executive Committee are developing a plan for lowering our expenses and bringing in additional monies from other sources. Our goal will be to adjust the budget so that there is the smallest possible impact on the ministries of the Church.

This letter is written to let you know that we have reason for concern and celebration. These are the facts and if you feel the need to increase your pledge for 2014, please do so. The fact that you made a pledge to the church for 2014 tells me that you take your giving seriously and I realize that I am asking a great deal by suggesting that you consider increasing that amount. Whether or not you are able to increase your giving in the coming year, I hope this letter has helped you to a better understanding in regards to our financial circumstances.

If you choose to increase the amount you intended to Pledge in 2014, please give the Church a call at 222-3684 and they will send you a new Pledge Card so that you can amend your Pledge.

We will continue to keep the Congregation apprised throughout the year on the importance of Stewardship.
