Week Five - The Easter Promise

The sun shone brightly and the sky was that beautiful clear blue more reminiscent of early spring days rather than the first Saturday in November. The mourners, following the polished and carved wood coffin, made their way to the graveside at the rest of a small hill. Rolling hills and lush woodlands stretched beyond the cemetery next to the small country church. When I had spoken with her she was touched and so grateful for the prayers of people she didn't even know. She was positive and hopefully optimistic about the new treatment, but as always, she placed herself in God's hands.

Now, only two weeks later, she was dead. And so it was that we had gathered to say our earthly good-byes to Suzannah.


I watched her three teenage children lay to rest their forty-six year old mother, and understood how hard this was for them, but I knew she had prepared them well. She had prepared them with her love and faith in God and with her faith in the Easter Promise.

It is in times like this you cling to the Easter Promise, usually seeing it in only a narrow view. The Easter Promise, of course, is so much more than being reunited with loved ones when we die. The Easter Promise is God's promise that through belief in Jesus Christ, we will not be separated from eternal life with God by sin. That Promise brought to fulfillment through Christ is the foundation of our faith.

The celebration of Easter helps us RENEW (Psalm 51:10) our seeking of spiritual guidance in our lives. It gives us the opportunity to REAFFIRM (Matthew 16:13-16), our own good Confession, our faith in Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the living God. It gives us a special time to search our minds and hearts to REPENT (Luke 24:45-49) of those sins. And in Christ's RESURRECTION (John 11:25-26) we REJOICE (Luke 1:46-47) because Jesus Christ is Lord and Savior and has RECONCILED (John 5:19-27) all believers to God. We give thanks that God has sent Him, so that we may all come to understand the full importance of the EASTER PROMISE.

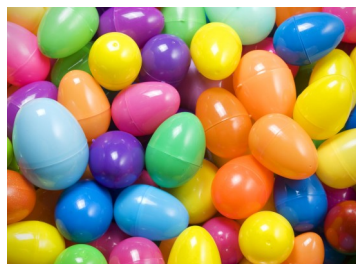
