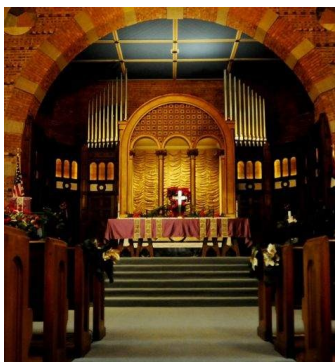

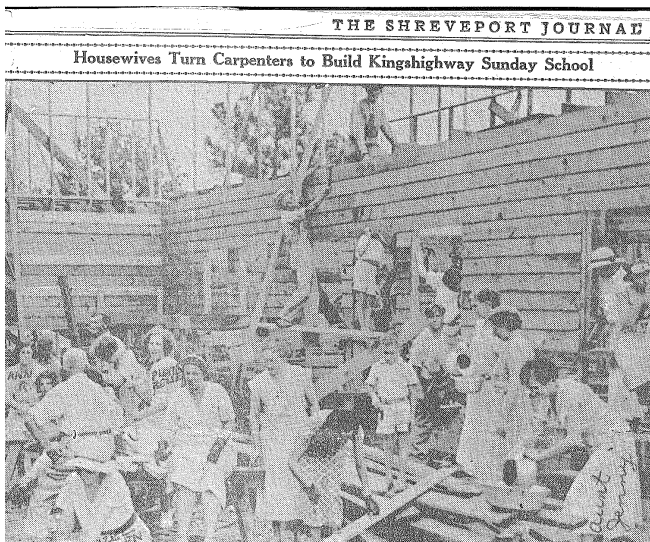

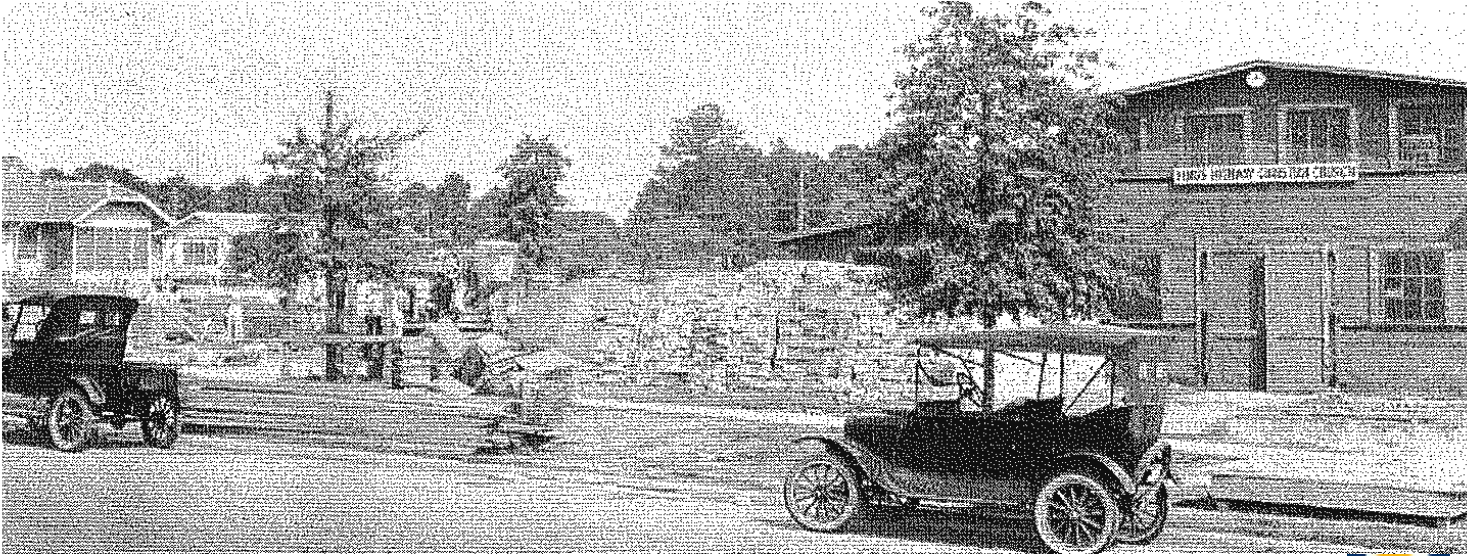
### Stewardship Moment

It is a great honor to be given the chance to sit and hear a person's story, to listen to his or her concerns, to relate news about the church, and to pray together. These are generally folks who are unable to make it to church, so this is our chance to let them know that they are missed and loved.

If this kind of ministry is of interest to you please know that we are considering beginning a new program here at KHCC that would give you the chance to personally provide spiritual comfort to those who are in particular need of a visit. These visitation volunteers will receive special training and work under the guidance of the church's Elders. 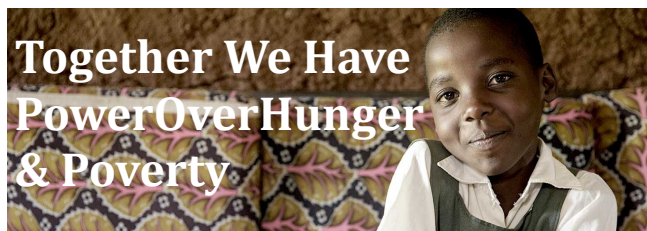
## KHCC Outreach Committee: Friendship House Academic Celebration

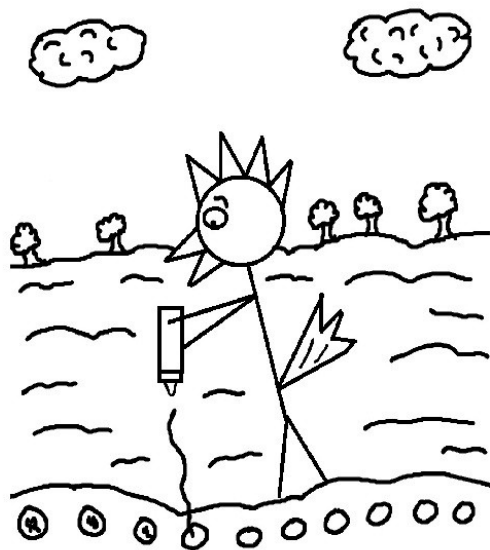
