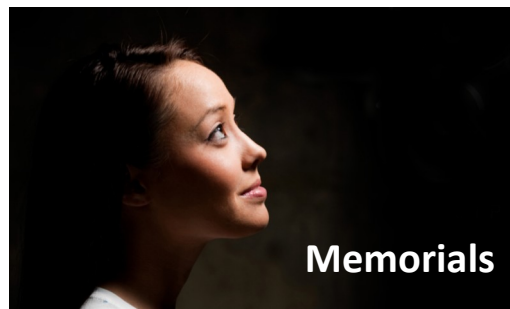

I FROM THE Minister

Here is a translation of the sermon that Jesús preached for me last Sunday... It's hard to believe it's the ten-year anniversary of our church's ministry to the Hispanic community. While I wasn't here when this ministry began I was the newly installed senior minister when we celebrated the first anniversary of this ministry back in 2005. A lot of things have changed since I was first introduced to this wonderful ministry. I remember when I first arrived Ellie and Jesús were so quiet, their offices were up on the third floor and they would sneak in and out, they rarely spoke at staff meetings. I thought they are too quiet and shy to be ministers. I don't think that anymore. It was clear that they weren't shy when I first I saw them ministering to our Spanish speaking members. And since Ellie moved into the office next to mine I have learned that she is neither quiet nor shy. The longer I know them and the more I experience of this ministry the more I am inspired.

When it comes to this special ministry, there are moments from the last ten years that I will particularly remember. I will remember the time that one of our members told me about how he brags to his friends and neighbors that his church has a service in Spanish and tells them about the important work that this ministry accomplishes. I will remember the work that went into creating our Casa Esperanza ministry the enthusiasm with which the members of the church heard this idea and how members from all three of our services have given their time and talents to support this ministry. This is a ministry that we have done together as one church, and it has made a profound difference in the lives of scores of families.

Most of all I will remember one particular Sunday, when, during one of our first combined services I was in the baptistery performing the baptism for a group of our youth all coming out in alphabetical order. Then when we got to the h's, out came Marco Hernandez and Jesús. And I stepped to the corner to watch and listen as Jesús spoke the same words I had spoken before baptizing each of our youth, but this time they were in Spanish. "Yo te bautizo en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo."

Standing there in the corner of the baptistery I felt God's Spirit at work in that place, in the life of that young man, and in my own heart. I will remember that moment for the rest of my life.

There are all reasons that I love this ministry. But there is another important reason I love this ministry. I love it because it is not easy; it is hard; it is a challenge to be the minister of a church that worships in three different ways and in two different languages. It is often a challenge to be a member of such a church. How much easier it would be if we all talked the same and looked the same and worshiped the same, but that's just not the church that God is calling us to be.

When the first Christians gathered together in Jerusalem in the months following Jesus death, it was a varied group. There were Jews there and Greeks, there were Pharisees there among the early Christians and there were Sadducees there too, there were Judeans and Galileans among those early Christians, slave and free, those who spoke mostly Greek and those who spoke Aramaic. How was it possible for them to be one church, how is it possible for us today. It is God's Spirit here among us that makes it possible for us to transcend our differences of culture and language. Just as God's Spirit came as a mighty wind on that first Pentecost and created one church out of that varied group of people, it is God's Spirit who makes it possible for us today to say in the words of the psalms. "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity." Then thanks be to God and thanks be to each of the members of this church for all its ministries and for the opportunity we have been given to accomplish them together.
