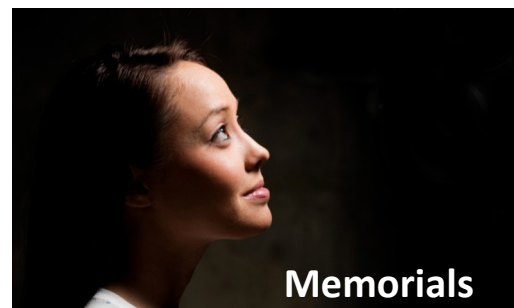
We celebrate with *Katy Hume & Trey Daniels* who were married November 22nd. Best wishes *Katy & Trey!*

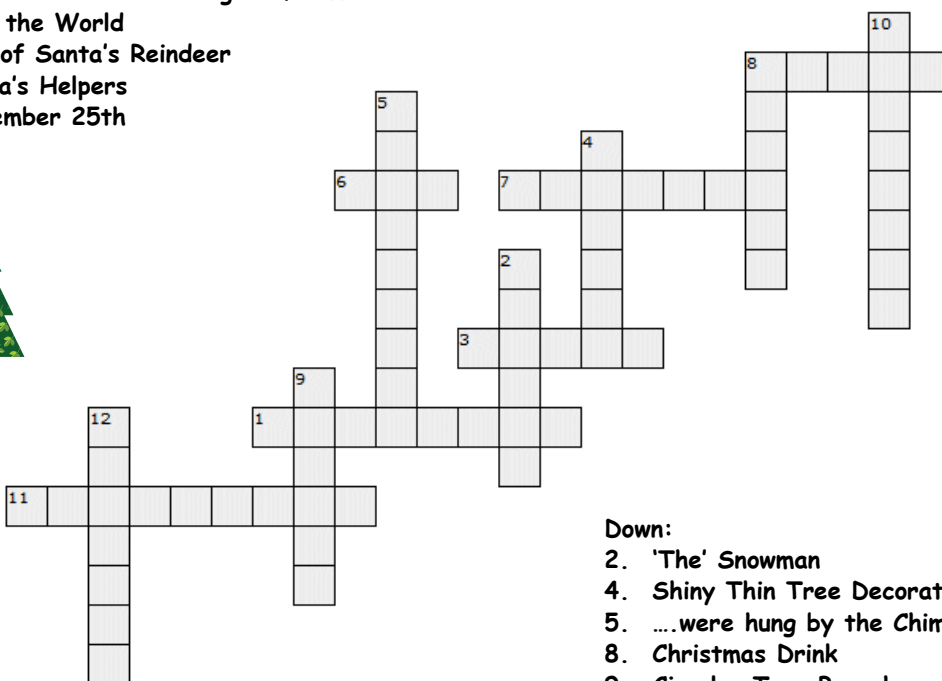
