

If you're new to Kings Highway Christian Church you may not realize what an amazing transformation has occurred here over the last two decades. There was no Family Life Center, no contemporary worship service or praise band, and no ministry to the Hispanic community or worship service in Spanish. Our ministry to the families of Shriners Hospital patients was not around and neither was the River Sunday school program for the kids. Our church has changed a great deal in the last 20 years, and change is never easy. It takes a congregation with lots of courage, faith, patience and love.

All this effort and hard work by our congregation has assured that we as a church remain focused <u>Forward</u>, <u>Outward</u>, and <u>Upward</u>. are focused on the needs that exist in our community through ministries like Casa Esperanza and the Highland Blessing Dinner. Our church and its members have worked hard over the last two decades so that we can continue to be a church focused <u>Forward</u>, <u>Outward</u> and **Upward**.




