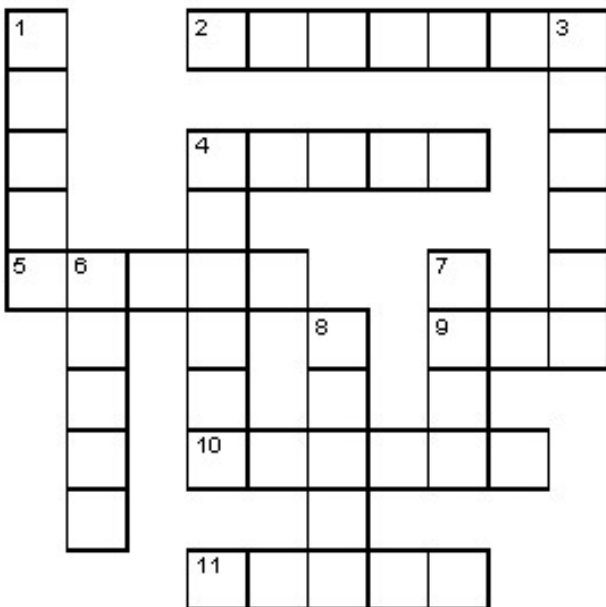

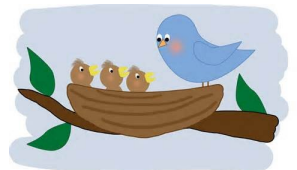

REINVEST IN CADDO COMMUNITY FORUM

On May 2, 2015, Caddo voters will go to the polls to vote on the "Reinvest in Caddo" plan. If the plan is approved, Caddo school leaders would close 6 schools and build 3 new ones, buy new buses and upgrade facilities throughout the district.

The Caddo Parish School Board will be asking voters to approve a bond proposition to reallocate an existing tax. The proposal would permit the district to use up to \$108 million in bonds and reallocate one-mil of a six-mil tax currently used to pay off previous bond issues. The bonds would be issued in a series and each issue would have a life of 20 years. District officials say the proposal would allow the school district to operate more efficiently, create better educational opportunities for students, eliminate unnecessary facilities not needed to house the district's students, prepare for population shifts, upgrade technology to focus on STEM instruction and career education, and rid the district of temporary buildings.

Three inner-city elementary schools would close: Barret Paideia Academy, Creswell Elementary and E.B. Williams-Stoner Hill Laboratory School. Jack P. Timmons and Blanchard elementary schools also are slated to close as is the Alexander Learning Center.

The House is lived in by Community Coordinators and their families to become the catalysts for rebuilding safe and caring neighborhoods. They spend time with the neighbors, earning their trust. The relationships they form become a foundation for residents to set and achieve basic goals in the areas of community, education, leadership, housing, health, safety and meaningful work.
